

One-to-One Tutoring

Learners are matched with tutors to work on individual goals in reading, writing, math, computer skills, and life skills. **Classes are 1 hour long, once a week.** This program runs all year, but there is a waiting list and there may be a break in your program. If you are new to the program, we will do an assessment to help you set your goals.

Gateway Small Group Classes

Learners Classes are offered Monday to Wednesday, in partnership with the Thames Valley District School Board. These classes provide an opportunity to work with others and practice literacy skills. Learners in these group classes must be able to work independently, work well with others, and actively participate. Classes start in January and finish in March. Classes are 9:00 am to 2:30 pm with a lunch break from 12:00 to 12:30. You must be able to attend for the full day, each week. Breaks, lunch and pick-ups are not supervised. You should provide your own lunch and snacks. Class sizes are limited.



The classes include a bit of the reading, writing and perhaps some math that you would use in everyday life. Each class will include some independent work time to work on a topic of interest to you. We will ask you to take a literacy assessment if you are new to the program to ensure you are ready.

Literacy classes have an academic focus, so if you are eager to learn, and have some basic skills already in place, a class may be perfect for you!
