

Hutton House Pottery Studio

Are you curious about learning to work with clay? Or maybe you're an experienced potter who wants to learn more advanced techniques? Come learn from experienced instructors in our state-of-the-art, fully accessible pottery studio.

The Hutton House Pottery Studio is located at 654 Wonderland Rd N, south of Oxford St. behind Subway restaurant. Classes and workshops are held on evenings and weekends and are open to teens and adults. Parking is free.

How do I register for classes?

You can register for classes and workshops by going to www.eventbrite.ca and searching "Hutton House", or give us a call to register over the phone. Classes are filled on a first come first served basis. There are minimum numbers required for classes to run; if a class needs to be cancelled due to low registration we will let you know a week before the start of the class and will refund your money. Please note: pickup dates are estimates and may change due to unforeseen circumstances.

How do I pay for classes?

You can pay through Eventbrite, or call us and pay by Visa or Mastercard over the phone at 519-472-6381. Or you may visit us in person and pay with cash, cheque, debit, Visa, Mastercard, or Debit Visa. Our regular business hours are weekdays from 8:30am-4:30pm. Please note we are closed on statutory holidays. Refunds are not available unless Hutton House cancels a class due to low registration.

Tools, and materials such as slips and glazes, are provided by Hutton House and are shared with all the classes. There are no extra charges for tools or materials unless noted in the description.
