

Hutton House Pottery Studio

Looking for a new hobby? Curious about learning to work with clay? Or maybe you're an experienced potter who wants to learn more advanced techniques? Come learn from experienced instructors in our state-of-the-art, fully accessible pottery studio. The Hutton House Pottery Studio is located at 654 Wonderland Rd N, south of Oxford St. behind Subway restaurant. Classes and workshops are held on evenings and weekends and are open to kids aged 6+, teens, and adults. Parking is free. Proceeds from our pottery classes and workshops go towards our innovative, inspiring programs for people with disabilities.

How do I register for classes?

You can register for classes and workshops by going to www.eventbrite.ca and searching "Hutton House", or give us a call to register over the phone. Classes are filled on a first come first served basis. There are minimum numbers required for classes to run; if a class needs to be cancelled due to low registration we will let you know a few days before the class starts and will refund your money. Please note: pickup dates are estimates and may change due to unforeseen circumstances. The instructor will confirm your pickup date.

How do I pay for classes?

You can pay through Eventbrite, or call us and pay by Visa or Mastercard over the phone at 519-472-6381. Or come see us in person and pay with cash, cheque, debit, Visa, Mastercard, or Debit Visa. Our regular business hours are weekdays from 8:30am-4:30pm. Refunds are not available unless Hutton House cancels a class due to low registration.

Are there any other fees?

If you already have clay leftover from a previous Hutton House class and do not need to purchase any, please let us know when you register. Tools, and materials such as slips and glazes, are provided by Hutton House and are shared with all the classes. There are no extra charges for tools or materials unless noted in the description.

You will be able to express your creativity through surface decorating and glazing and you will finish the course with practical and fun pieces!
