flashcards








# Sounds and Words Books

- For learners who are beginning to learn the letters and consonant sounds
- Introduces letters and sounds in a meaningful context with words and simple books
- Focuses on initial letter sounds and introduces middle and final consonant sounds, words and the concept of rhyming words







# The Opposites Books

- For learners who know some of the letters and consonant sounds
- Encourages the use of picture clues, patterns, phonics and sight words
- Provides practice with reading, writing and consonant sounds in the context of words and simple books








## The Pattern Books 1

- For learners who know most consonant sounds,recognize some words and are starting to sound out words
- Introduces short vowel sounds, sight words and many other language skills
  includes many task-based activities
- Encourages the use of sight words, picture clues, context clues and decoding strategies to be able to find information and understand a variety of printed materials



# The Pattern Books 2




For learners who know many common sight words and can sound out many one-syllable short vowel words
