Join us to have fun and play some educational games. Some reading skills are helpful, but we will help each other out. We'll play some Jeopardy, word games, and more.

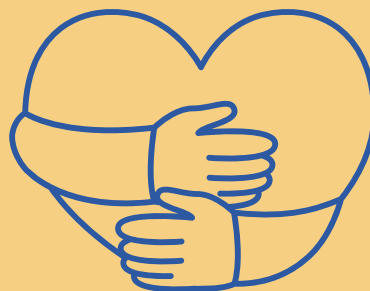

No past experience with robots or coding is necessary.

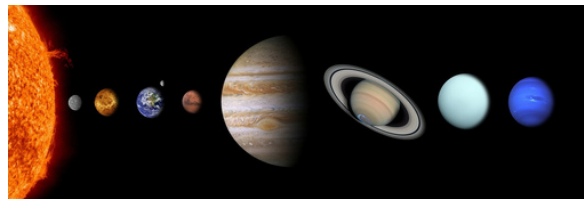

## The Idea Club

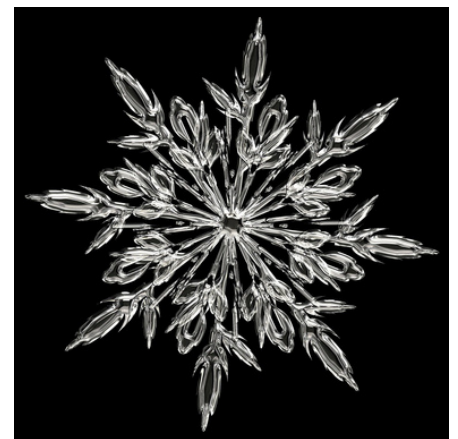

Please note: Tutoring will increase to \$35 an hour on April 1, 2024.

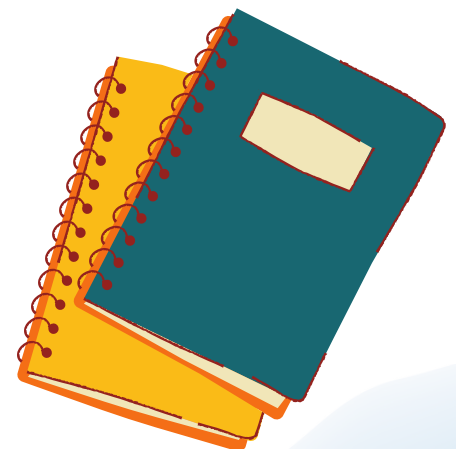
**Work on your own goals at your own pace!**

# Gateway to Learning

**Group literacy classes are offered in partnership with the Thames Valley District School Board**

**Limited spaces are available**

Practice **your literacy** skills during these small group classes. **Classes are in-person at The Learning Centre.** Learners must be able to work independently, work well with others, and actively participate. You must be able to attend for the full day each week. Breaks, lunches, and pick-ups are not supervised. Bring your own lunch and snacks.

The classes will focus on reading, writing and comprehension. They might include some everyday math. If you are new to the program, we will do a mini-assessment to make sure the program is a good fit for you.

If you were in the Gateway class in the fall, you will be automatically registered for the winter. Please let us know if you have met your goals or are moving on.

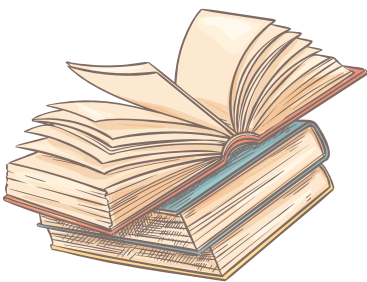
